May 11 Speaker Steve Weinberger, W-Trans Consultant

Steve Weinberger, a transportation consultant from Oakland, was in town last week to solicit input from Paso Robles residents on the Creston Road improvement project. Creston Road currently needs repaving and other options for improving traffic flow and safety are also under consideration. Creston Road currently has a hodgepodge of sections with 2 to 5 lanes creating bottlenecks where traffic lanes are reduced. It is a priority project for Public Works Director Dick McKinley. Among the options (and estimated costs) under consideration are (A) a combination of 3-5 lanes for traffic (\$8-\$11 M) (B) a five-lane Creston Road (\$23-\$25 M) or (C) paving only (\$4-\$6 M). A final public discussion at Lewis Middle School last Thursday culminated in a vote by residents favoring Option A that includes new bike lanes and sidewalks. *(Thanks to Rex Thornhill for photo & meeting notes)*
