Tom Dobyns, Board President Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) for Children

Tom Dobyns received a heart-felt introduction from Rick Goree on the critical work of CASA in improving the lives of abused and neglected children. Rick, along with Gail Tannehill, have served as mentors for CASA and have seen first hand how it makes a huge difference in the lives of these children. Tom provided a powerful presentation on the challenges and achievements of CASA noting "we are winning!".

Tom has invested over 30 years in volunteer public service. Tom's work helping children began in Orange County where he served for 22 years on the board of Orangewood Children's Foundation. His professional life was in banking where Tom last served as CEO of Mission Community Bank. He began his career as a teller, commercial lender and branch manager at Bank of America almost 40 years ago. Tom has an undergraduate degree and MBA from USC. He currently lives with his wife in Shell Beach and operates a consulting firm, Enthusiology.



Tom began his presentation with some sobering statistics. There are about 500 children in foster care in the county awaiting adjudication. Of these, 90% have physical or mental maladies, 50% have drug or alcohol issues in the home, and 65% of those who leave the system are homeless with 50% unemployed and 20% incarcerated. 70% of the inmates at the Men's Colony in SLO were foster kids. CASA aims to help these unfortunate victims by providing them with adult mentors who provide guidance and encouragement as they navigate the court system.

The local CASA organization was started 23 years ago in SLO. It currently serves about 170 of the 500 children in the system. CASA operates on an annual budget of \$800K with five paid supervisors overseeing 30 volunteers each. The CASA budget has grown thanks to a generous \$250K/4 year grant by MUST Charities. With only one third of the kids currently served, Tom urged members to consider volunteering as a mentor, making a donation or helping with one of their fundraisers. They particularly need men as only 10% of mentors are male.
