## **Dick McKinley, Public Works Director City of Paso Robles**

One issue of keen interest to club members is the status of our local roads and what is being done to improve their condition. While Public Works Director Dick McKinley has a large portfolio of facilities and services within his department, the presentation and subsequent Q&As were all about road projects and issues.

John Hamon provided the introduction of Dick who was appointed Public Works Director in Paso Robles in April 2015. Dick has 35 years of experience in city government and was previously the public works director in Surprise, AZ. Prior to that, he held similar public works jobs in several cities in Washington State. Dick grew up in Michigan. He has a bachelor's degree in economics from Michigan State University and a



master's degree in public administration from Portland State University. He lives with his wife Louann in Paso Robles and has 4 children & 5 grandchildren. He is actively involved in scouting.

Dick's presentation centered on how his department determines the priority and timing of road maintenance work. Of note, maintenance is not solely prioritized by the condition of roads or how much traffic they carry. According to Dick, his department uses a methodology called Critical Point Management that focuses resources "on keeping good roads good". Rebuilding roads is extremely expensive costing roughly \$11 per sq ft. Keeping roads in good repair defers more costly re-paving efforts. Things like crack sealing are very cost effective at preserving pavement and offer better value for taxpayers. The City is currently spending about \$5 million annually on road repairs. Dick estimated it would cost \$12 million to keep up with current needs and \$25 million to get all roads repaired & maintained in good condition.

Dick showed good command of all questions regarding specific road projects and issues. It is evident that more resources dedicated to road projects are needed to keep our roads properly maintained.
