Courtney Howard

Water Resources Division Manager - San Luis Obispo County

As our county Water Resources Division manager, Courtney Howard has the challenge of coordinating a complex and byzantine set of federal, state & local regulations governing water resources for our county. Her mission statement and goal is to be an effective partner in achieving sustainable water resources for all areas of SLO County.

Courtney is a graduate of Cal Poly with a degree in environmental engineering. She grew up in Vacaville and now lives in Paso Robles with her husband, Jeremy.

Courtney's presentation focused on the myriad of rules, entities, and methodologies that will be used to comply with the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA). The goal of this state law is to have all groundwater basins sustainable in 20 years.



There are numerous entities involved including the Department of Water Resources (DWR) that regulates and manages water resources at the state level. There are a variety of Groundwater Sustainability Agencies (GSAs) charged with the planning and implementation of Groundwater Sustainability Plans (GSP) that cover individual basins.

In SLO County, there are six basins: San Luis Obispo Valley, Cuyama Valley, Santa Maria Valley, Los Osos Valley, Salinas Valley - Atascadero Sub Basin, and Salinas Valley - Paso Robles Sub Basin. Each basin or sub basin can be governed by a single GSA and single GSP, but many have a combination of multiple GSAs and/or multiple GSPs. This overlap of agencies and plans requires extensive coordination.

Courtney noted that "effective collaboration is the key". In the Paso Robles Sub Basin, current work is centered on creating sustainable management criteria and a reliable monitoring network as well as projects and management actions to manage demand and enhance supply.
