Kate Morgans, Chief Executive Officer Boys & Girls Club of North SLO County

Kate Morgans left the business world almost two years ago to serve our community as the local leader of Boys & Girls Club of North County. Kate previously served on the organization's Board of Directors from 2008-2014. She is now applying her business and people skills to run an essential non-profit that provides support to over 1,500 children on a current budget of just over \$550K per year. Their mission statement is "To enable all young people, especially those who need us most, to reach their full potential as productive, caring, responsible citizens".

Kate has an impressive academic and business background. She has an undergraduate degree from William & Mary and an MBA from Dartmouth's Tuck School of Business. She held a variety of corporate positions in sales, marketing and executive services before moving west with her family to Paso Robles in 2008. She initially joined Morgan Stanley as a financial advisor and then started her own firm, Adelaide Wealth Advisors, in 2011. She passed her business on to a husband and wife team when she was appointed CEO of the Boys & Girls Club. She is now focused full-time on meeting the club's key challenges.

The Boys and Girls Club of North County currently has both an after-school and a summer school program offered in both Paso Robles and Atascadero. They provide an array of productive and healthy activities in a safe and nurturing environment. These programs are truly essential for most of the participating families that have limited resources to care for their children while not at school. Virtually all of the parents are employed and half are single parent homes. About 70% qualify for free or reduced price lunch meals. Kate noted that over 4,000 children in North County lack an affordable after school program with 80% living in either Paso Robles or Atascadero. So investing in the Boys & Girls Club is a great way to help ensure that these programs can address the growing needs of our community in supporting academic achievement, healthy lifestyles and character development of our future generation.
