## Dave Hovde, Chief Meteorologist, KSBY TV

Dave Hovde is one of the more recognizable and engaging local personalities in the county as the weatherman for KSBY. He came to KSBY in 2003 from Fargo, North Dakota, and his career spans over 20 years in broadcasting. Hovde currently provides the Central Coast weather Monday through Friday at 5:00, 6:00, 6:30 and 11:00 PM. Hovde is a member of the American Meteorological Society and the National Weather Association. Dave received Golden Mike awards for "Best Weather Television Segment" in 2003, 2006 and 2007.



While Hovde came to KSBY from ND, he has previous experience in CA, having served as chief meteorologist at KERO-TV in Bakersfield. Dave is a graduate of Minnesota State University and also attended Mississippi State and Portland State universities. He has two boys, Ethan and Campbell, who attend Paso Robles schools.

Dave started his presentation by playing a tape of feedback he received from viewers who often call him out when they think he got the forecast wrong.

Being a meteorologist obviously requires thick skin as well as a good sense of humor and self. Dave takes the criticism in stride and notes that forecasts continue to get more accurate as computer models get better and more data is available to drive them. While meteorologists utilize numerous models, Dave noted that the European ECMWF is more accurate than the American GFS model. Generally speaking, forecasts cannot be accurately made more than 14 days out.

Dave reported that Paso Robles received 6.89" of rain in January and 10.57" since the start of the rain year on October 1, the most since 1997. The region's drought remains categorized as "severe" although this is much better than the "extreme" or "exceptional" categories we were in prior to January. We need another 12-18" of rain to get out of severe category.

In closing, Dave quipped "climate change is real-chemtrails are not".
