Chris Williams, Supervisor **Paso Robles School District**

It was the Chris Williams show at Rotary last week with Chris sharing details of the new Facility Master Plan for the expenditure of the

Measure M funds. The \$95 million Measure M general expenditure bond was approved by local voters in November, 2016. Chris and his team have been working on plans for ten high priority infrastructure projects that would utilize these bond funds. Before discussing several of these projects, Chris noted that Paso Robles School District is the only district in the county with a growing enrollment, now at 7,004 students. The school district has a total budget of \$76.8 M and is the largest employer in SLO County with over 800 employees.



Chris was introduced by former school district supervisor and club president Pat Sayne. Pat remarked on Chris's vision and leadership that is driving the outstanding academic and extracurricular results for the school district. Chris came to our district in August 2014. He was previously Assistant Superintendent of Central Unified School District in Fresno County. Chris grew up in Fresno and received his BS from Cal State University Fresno in 1994 and his ME from National University in 1997. He and his wife Megan have two daughters, Jordan and Brittany.

While the new Facility Master Plan includes 10 priority projects, Chris provided members with a more detailed overview of three projects including the Marie Bauer Early Childhood Education Center, the Glen Speck Academy of the Arts and the Aquatics Complex. The Glen Speck project is the most expensive on the Master Plan utilizing almost \$22 M in bond funds. It will result in 20 new classrooms, a new computer lab, library and athletic field renovations. The Marie Bauer Pre-School project (\$11 M) will provide 10 new classrooms, play area and parking. The new Aquatic Complex (\$5.7 M) would include new 50 meter and 25 yard pools, bleachers, changing and restrooms. It is envisioned that the complex would be used to host large CIF sanctioned swim meets.
