Shawn Sherman Central California Cannabis Council

Shawn Sherman is the owner of Golden Apple Cannabis, a local boutique medical marijuana collective and delivery service. He is involved with numerous local cannabis industry organizations such as SLO NORML, SLO Cannabis Collaborative, the North County Chapter of the California Growers Alliance, and the Central Coast Cannabis Council (CCCC). Last Thursday, he was presenting information on behalf of the CCCC. Shawn was accompanied by Chris Matthews who is the communication director for the CCCC. Shawn is a native of Paso



Robles and has a degree in computer science. Shawn began by discussing the growing trend

toward legalization of marijuana in the U.S. Thirty states and WDC currently have laws broadly legalizing marijuana in some form. Eight states and WDC have adopted laws legalizing marijuana for recreational use. According to one national poll, 64% of those responding believe cannabis should be legalized. In CA, Prop. 64 to legalize recreational use passed with 57% in favor.

Shawn provided some interesting statistics asserting that states with legal marijuana have seen a 14% reduction in opioid prescriptions and 23% lower addiction rates. He also noted there has been no increase in traffic fatalities in Colorado since it legalized recreational marijuana. It was pointed out by one attendee that trying to link cause and effects between legalization and addiction rates or traffic fatalities was inappropriate. Shawn also noted that legal cannabis sales have a positive impact on the economy with sales in CO of \$1.5 B in 2017 and projected sales in CA of \$5.1 B in 2018. Sean also discussed the various active ingredients in cannabis that provide its therapeutic benefits including reduced inflammation and pain. There was also a discussion on future policy issues including how to determine if someone is under the influence while driving, deterring minors from using cannabis and deterring public consumption by licensing various 'on-site "facilities.
