Must! Charities was formed in 2012 by local business leaders and other friends who had a vision to create a public gifting organization where they could combine their resources toward toward local initiatives they couldn't fund or manage on their own.

Becky was hired as the first executive director after running the SLO Wine Association where she worked with many of the wine industry leaders who are key contributors to Must!Charities. She and her husband Randy moved to Templeton from SLO in 1998. She loves the slower pace of life and the friendly, caring people who live here.

Their efforts to date are very impressive with current multi-year commitments to numerous local organizations including: Boys & Girls Club (\$140,000), Big Brother Big Sister (\$252,371), Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) for Children (\$252,551), and the El Camino Homeless Organization (ECHO) (\$500,000). The size and duration of these commitments are intended to provide sustainable resources to meet community needs over many years. Funds are distributed in installments over time based on bench marks met each quarter by the individual charities.
