George Poulakos, Rotary Club of Ventura

George Poulakos is a great example of how one motivated Rotary member can change the world through the Global Grant Program. George has been working for years to establish the Grace Centre to help young women get a high school degree in Kazungula, Zambia. George has been working hard to secure support from numerous Rotary clubs and leverage these local contributions through the resources of the Rotary International Global Grant Program. George just received another commitment of \$5,000 from his Ventura Club that was matched by the Ventura Club South leaving them just \$14,000 short of their goal!



George originally got involved in this project during a business trip to South Africa that also took him to Zambia. George saw the very primitive economy in Zambia that provided virtually no opportunity to educate and train the majority of young women in the region. These girls are often recruited to participate in the local sex trade as they have no other viable means of support. The Grace Center provides a place for young women to develop skills needed to

support their quest for a high school education. There are three primary areas of skill development: (1) tailoring that provides uniforms for school and other clothing for commercial sales, (2) valuable computer skills that are taught at a computer training center, and (3) food preparation and catering to serve the needs of local hospitals and other institutions that currently have no food service capabilities.

The Livingston Rotary Club of Zambia is the local lead for the administration of the Global Grants for the Grace Centre. Rotary is one of the few trusted organizations in Zambia where corruption often results in the failure of international relief efforts to assist the poor. Club member Gary Barker, who spent years working in Zambia as a missionary, endorsed George's efforts to support the Grace Center with local oversight provided by the reputable Livingston Club.
