Julie Opheim, PR Branch & SLO County Sales Manager Placer Title Company

Julie Opheim is branch manager of Placer Title Company in Paso Robles, but really enjoys her role as sales manager for all of SLO County. including 4 offices in Paso Robles, San Luis Obispo, Cambria and Morro Bay. Julie provided a very useful public service by speaking about the problem of wire fraud and money laundering that impacts title companies and other businesses across the country and around the world.

Julie (*right*) has been with Placer Title since 2014 and previously worked at First American Title for nine years. She lives in Paso Robles with her husband David, a sergeant with the Paso Robles Police

Department. They have two children, a daughter who is with the U.S. Army and a son who is a senior at PRHS.

Julie highlighted the growing problem of wire fraud noting that the industry lost over \$1B to real estate wire fraud last year, up from only \$19M the year before. Julie provided several scenarios that are used by criminals to steal escrow funds. The first involved a call to an escrow officer and providing detailed information such as the escrow



number and property address. The second involved a gmail account from a buyer that was hacked by someone in South Africa who requested funds to be wired from the buyer. The third involved paperwork sent in with fraudulent wiring instructions. Fortunately, in all three cases, the escrow agent thwarted the fraud through a variety of measures included requiring wiring instructions to be notarized, face to face contact with the seller before transferring funds, and close verbal communications with buyers, sellers and agents. Julie provided several other security tips: use company e-mail vs. personal accounts when possible, use encryption and two factor authentication to avoid hacking, don't send personal information via e-mail, avoid free public WIFI when viewing private information, and change passwords every 90 days. Most importantly, be vigilant & suspicious, confirm & verify everything, and report suspicious activity.
