Almond Acres Charter Academy (AACA) is a K-8 charter school founded in 2010 and located in San Miguel. Bob Bourgault was appointed as the Executive Director of the school in 2012. The school's mission is to help students succeed academically and socially by educating the whole child: heart, body, mind and soul. AACA has implemented a model of learning and teaching into the curriculum and instruction using concepts in the Formation of Learning (FOL) Framework that allows teachers to focus on diverse learning styles and intelligences while providing the creative application of knowledge and reasoning skills.

Bob Bourgault was a key hire for the school. He has been an educator for 30 years and has two master's degrees from the University of La Verne; one in curriculum, instruction and assessment and the other in education, counseling and guidance. He also has his Tier One Administrative, a Pupil Personnel Services credential, and a Cross-cultural Language & Academic Development (CLAD) credential. He also serves as an adjunct professor for the University of LaVerne teacher education program and an active Paid Call Firefighter (PCF) for SLO County Fire/Cal Fire. He and his wife Susie have seven children.

Among the many distinct features of AACA is the integration of subjects that allows students to make real-world connections and foster problem solving. This integration strengthens skills that students encounter in one subject area, but also use in another thereby promoting a mastery of skills. It also better reflects real experiences in the world. Family participation is another area of emphasis that contributes to the success of the school. Parents or guardians are asked to fulfill this commitment by assisting in the classroom, chaperoning field trips, organizing fundraisers, and participating in the governance of the school.

AACA is demonstrating the value of charter schools in providing students with innovative approaches tailored to their individual needs.
